**The Annual Town Meeting**, held in said Town and County, Nunda Township Hall, 3510 Bay Road, Crystal Lake, IL. Tuesday, April 14, 2015.

The meeting was called to order by Angela Koscavage, Township Clerk. The following official business was recorded:

Angela Koscavage, Township Clerk called the meeting to order at 7 p.m.

**Public Comments:**

Mary McClellan of 3014 S. Bergman Ave, McHenry, - Noted there was a Referendum passed on March 2014, (which appeared on the Nunda Township resident's ballot), regarding garbage service in Nunda Township. Garbage service has been approved. She commented on her bill with positive thanks for the Board for their hard work.

Sue Ruacanski of 3712 Burton Trail, C.L. - Wanted info as to when the voting for the garbage pickup was introduced and where in the Referendum was it mentioned.

Charleen Kaiser of 5114 E. Hillside Road, C.L. - Agreed with Mary McClellan that her garbage bill has been cut and she was pleased.

Tom Palmer of 6801 Concord Trail, C.L. - Commented on the garbage contract and noted there are approximately 4,500 households in Nunda Township.

Catherine Pahlke of 1716 Road, C.L. - Stated she is paying \$168 for new garbage pickup. She was thrilled with the new bid.

Steve Platt of 784 Flint Trail, C.L. - Pleased fewer trucks are on his road.

Lee Jennings of 730 Area Street, McHenry - Read the article which appeared in the Nunda Township Spring Edition/2015 newsletter (front page) regarding the referendum voters passed on waste and recycling services for the Township's unincorporated areas.

Lee Jennings, Supervisor - Township is in great financial shape.

**Patricia D. Morris, Cemetery Board** - The residents of Nunda Township own four cemeteries. The names and locations were given on a hand-out. They are carefully maintained in order to preserve the dignity of those who are interred there. 600 plots are available. The tax is down two dollars for each property owner. The price per plot is \$450. There are no plans to expand the cemeteries at this point. This includes burial & monument permits, measuring prior to burial and perpetual care. The annual tax for the cemetery fund for each property owner averages \$1.00 or less per year.
